



Chart of a Standard Township & Neighboring Sections Used in Federal Land Records

Key: T = township, R = range, S = section. N = north, W = west. Note that four neighboring townships meet at the double-line corners in the chart. Townships were numbered north or south of a “base line” (a latitude line) when surveyed. Ranges were numbered east or west of a principal meridian (longitude line) when surveyed.
